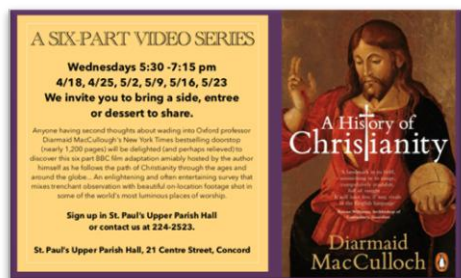
Six Week Sunday Bible Study: Blessed Are You
