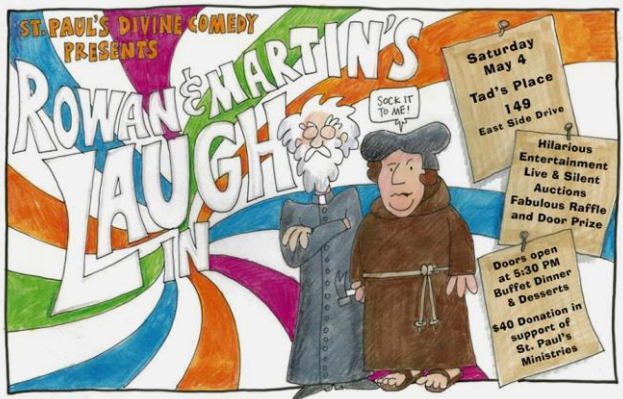


Mark Your Calendars for Divine Comedy

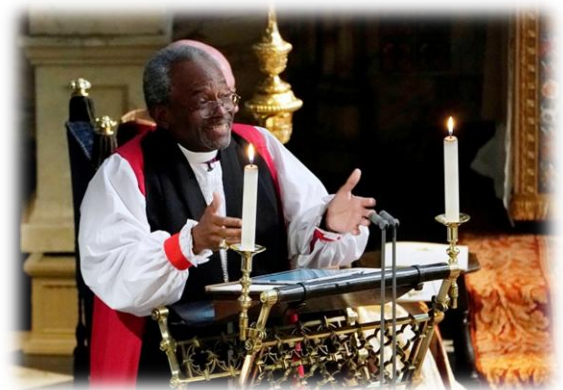
