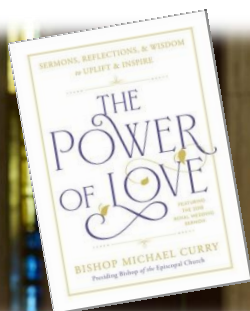


"The Power of Love" Discussion Series
