### **SafeChurch**

SafeChurch is a training required by the Diocese (per a greater Episcopal Church General Convention resolution) to help ensure the physical and emotional safety of those who are most vulnerable in our congregation. SafeChurch certification is required for many of our ministries and is recommended for all. The training consists of online modules plus one online group video conference call with Diocesan House staff. Certification lasts three years.
